Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- ➔ Narrow and sharpen the school's explicit improvement agenda to include targets, short- and medium-term milestones, timelines and accountable officers, and promote this widely amongst staff and the community.
- ➔ Review and refine the whole-school curriculum plan to provide clear documentation of the three levels of planning.
- ➔ Systematically monitor, review and evaluate the effectiveness of human and financial resource allocations to maximise outcomes for all students.
- ➔ Establish and embed systematic quality assurance into the curriculum planning process and the use of marking guides to guarantee aspects of the Australian Curriculum achievement standards are taught and assessed.
- ➔ Provide focused professional development for all teachers to increase data literacy skills utilising formative and summative assessments to identify next steps for student learning.
